Constitution

Roy Creek Ramblers 4-H Club

Article I. Name and Purpose

- Section 1. The name of is organization shall be Roy Creek Ramblers 4-H Club.
- Section 2. The purpose of this organization will be:
 - A. To create opportunities for youth to grow and to do their best, both individually and collectively.
 - B. To provide a better understanding of our community, country, and world.
 - C. Offer project based educational programming.
 - D. To provide leadership opportunities for youth within an organization.

Article II. Membership

- Section 1. Members must be between K-13 Grades
- Section 2. Member must attend seven (7) meetings a year to remain as an active club member.
- Section 3. Member must be an active member of a Green Lake County 4-H Club to exhibit at the local County Fair.
- Section 4. No person shall on the grounds of race, color, creed, religion, national origin, ancestry, sex, sexual orientation, marital or parental status, pregnancy, veteran's status, non-job related conviction record or qualified disability be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any aspect of the Green Lake County 4-H Leaders Association, including, but not limited to, all programs and activities.

Article III. Officers

Section 1.

- A. The president shall be elected annually.
- B. The vice-president shall be elected annually.
- C. The secretary shall be elected annually.
- D. The treasurer shall be elected annually.
- E. The reporter shall be elected annually.
- F. The pledge leader shall be elected annually.

Section 2. Officers are required to attend 90% of all meetings; after three (3) consecutive absences, the office will be considered vacant.

Section 3. Vacancy (Permanent/Resignation/Relocation)

If a vacancy occurs an election shall be held at the next regular meeting of the organization to replace the member.

Article IV. Committees

Article V. Meetings

Section 1. This organization shall hold nine (9) regular meetings each year.

Section 2. This fiscal year runs October 1st to September 30th.

Section 3. Meetings will be held the 3rd Monday of each month September thru May. Written meeting notices shall be sent or a phone will be made to all members in the event schedule change.

Article VI. Amendments

Section 1. The Constitution may be amended at any time by a twothirds majority of the members present. Notice must be given at a previous meeting or through notification by mail regarding the change in the constitution being considered.

Article VII: Audit Section 1.

At the close of each fiscal year, an audit committee of one to two people appointed by the general leader, shall examine the books and the accounts of the Roy Creek Ramblers 4-H Club. All finding shall be reported on the appropriate forms and turned in to the U.W. Extension office for filing.

Bylaws

Article I. Duties of the Officers

Section 1. President: Shall preside at all meetings of this Club. Shall act as chairman of the Executive board.

Section 2. <u>Vice-President:</u> Shall preside in the absence of the President and take care of all duties of the President during his/her absence.

- Section 3. Secretary: Shall keep minutes of all meetings of this Club. Shall work with the Club General Leader in getting out correspondence and communications necessary.
- Section 4. Treasurer: Shall collect and care for all money and dues of this Club. Shall pay bills as are ordered by the membership.
- Reporter: Shall keep a record of all club activities. Shall Section 5. submit photos and articles for publication. Shall keep a Club scrapbook to be displayed at the County Fair.
- Pledge Leader: Shall lead the Pledge of Allegiance and 4-H Section 6. Pledge at all meetings. Shall make sure all flags are properly displayed at all meetings.
- All the above officers may be assisted by general leader or Section 7. other adult volunteer if club needs surpass abilities of individual.

Article II. Election of Officers

Section 1. Method of Nomination: Officers shall be nominated from the floor at the October meeting. All officers cannot serve more than two (2) consecutive terms.

Article III. Quorum

General Leader

Section 1. A quorum shall consist of 50% of the Club's membership.

Article VI. Meeting Governance

Section 1. All meetings shall be governed by Roberts Rules of Order.
