



What is a Clothing Preview?

A Clothing Preview is a fashion show in which the participants model garments they have made. A judge evaluates them on many aspects of their garment's appearance, including grooming, fit, selection, construction, accessories and pressing. In this way, the participants can present the total look of their outfit themselves to a judge and an audience. The members have the chance to develop poise, learn more about fashion and general appearance, and develop a sense of pride in the garments they planned and made.

For the audience who attends, the Clothing Preview can teach them color coordination, how to accessorize, wardrobe planning, principles of design and fashion trends.



The following are the grades and project level categories:

Cloverbuds (K-2) & Grades 3-5

Beginning projects, garments for self

Grades 6-8

Intermediate projects, garments for self or others

Grades 9-13

Senior projects, garments for self or another individual

Invite your family and friends to attend the Clothing Preview so they can see the results of your hard work. Also, you'll enjoy the fun of making and presenting your own special project, selected and constructed by you.

If you wish to participate in the Preview, select a project by checking the project listings and discussing it with your parents and project leader. Select and purchase the necessary materials required to complete your project, as well as any accessories you want to complete your "total look." Complete the pre-registration form **as well as** the information sheet. **Both** must be submitted to the UW-Extension Office by the deadline date.

Please note that Clothing Preview garments must be displayed at the County Fair and also may be entered in the Junior Clothing Section at the Fair. A Public Style Show will be held Sunday afternoon of the Fair at which time all Clothing Preview participants will again model their garments. *Garments must be judged, displayed and modeled or a member will forfeit premium money.*
