Fairgoers will be treated to one of the fair's most exciting events. Exhibitors involved in the 4-H Dog project will compete in the judged Dog Agility Course as they direct their dogs through an obstacle course in a race for both time and accuracy. Spectators will be treated to the exceptional training of the animals and coordination of handler as controls are limited to voice, movement and various body signals. This event will be held on Saturday, August 4 at 10:00 a.m. and will be held on the south side of the track.

Spectators will also be treated to a ThrillSeeker Dog Sports Show by Missi Roland on Saturday, August 4 in between the judged Dog Rally and Dog Agility Competition. The 11:30 a.m. start time is approximate. ThrillSeeker Dog Sports will provide a dog sports program including tricks and meet & greet.
