

GREEN LAKE COUNTY 4-H TRIP AND AWARD APPLICATION



4-H Missions in Space (Space Camp) – Huntsville, Alabama (April 25-29, 2019)

4-H Missions in Space is a fun-filled educational weekend at the U.S. Space & Rocket Center in Huntsville, AL: participants will complete a simulated Space Shuttle mission, experience training simulators, tour the U.S. Space & Rocket Center and learn about becoming an astronaut. *Participation as a delegate is open to enrolled 4-H members in good standing in their counties who are in 6th – 8th grades. (The trips costs about \$625 with three (3) \$350.00 scholarships available from the Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association)*

RECENTLY ADDED → → → American Spirit – Travels East (June 7-16, 2019 or July 5-14, 2019)

The American Spirit trip is one that you will be traveling with approximately 40 other youth from Wisconsin. It is a trip that you will learn about America's heritage and build awareness of the many steps taken to gain United States independence and freedom by visiting historical sites in Philadelphia, New York, Boston and more. *Participation as a delegate is open to all 4-H youth in 8th-10th grades. (The trip costs about \$1400 with up to two (2) \$800 scholarships available from the Green Lake County Leaders' Association)*

Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference – Madison, WI (June 24-27, 2019)

The Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference is a great way to travel, meet new people from around the state of Wisconsin, visit Madison's wonderful attractions, and choose various project areas to learn more about. Some of the fun and educational workshops are kayaking and other water sports, art, photography, poetry writing, and agriculture. Participation as a delegate is open to all 4-H youth in 7th-10th grades. (The trip costs about \$250 with up to five (5) \$150 scholarships available from the Green Lake County Leaders' Association

Citizenship Washington Focus, Washington, D.C. – (June 15-23 or July 6-14, 2019)

4-H members ages 15-19 have the opportunity to travel to D.C. with others from the state of Wisconsin and spend a week at the National 4-H Center in Chevy Chase, Maryland. In addition to attending workshops on democracy, participants will visit memorials commemorating our nation's leaders and representing our victories and defeats on the battlefield, venture through the Smithsonian Museum, chat with our nation's leaders, and see citizenship in action. Participants must be in 10th – 12th grade to apply. (The trip costs about \$1400 with one (1) \$800 scholarship available from the Green Lake County Leaders' Association)

National Congress – Atlanta, Georgia (November 29-December 3, 2019)

It takes some forward thinking to prepare for National Congress trip. Considered the flagship of the 4-H trips, it is an opportunity to visit another state with 4-H members across the nation. Service learning and leadership will be key in this six day trip. Applicants must be in 10th - 12th grade at time of selection. Maximum age is 18 as of January 1st. (The trip costs about \$1,200 with one (1) \$800 scholarship available from the Green Lake County Leaders' Association)

Wisconsin 4-H Key Award

The highest level of award that can be achieved by a 4-H member in the State of Wisconsin, it is an achievement only a few can be proud to receive. The Key Award is presented to 4-H members that have shown growth and strong involvement throughout their participation in 4-H. They also need to show participation in club, county and community activities. *Applicants must be in* 10th - 13th grade at time of selection and a member of Green Lake County 4-H for a minimum of three years. There are up to two (2) awards available each year.

Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association Academic Scholarship

The Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association each year sponsors three (3) \$500.00 academic scholarships that can be used at any public or private college, university or technical school. Youth can only be selected once for this scholarship. Applicants must be a high school senior or college freshman at time of selection and a member of Green Lake County 4-H for a minimum of three years. There are up to three (3) scholarships available each year.
