## 2019 GUIDELINES FOR JUDGING SCHOLARSHIP

This Memorial Scholarship is in honor of Margaret "Jean" Hollander who served the community through her life-long dedication to education and public service as an educator, a county extension agent, food service manager, leader of the Wisconsin Extension Homemakers, County Board supervisor, 4-H volunteer and as a judge at county fairs. Mrs. Hollander was an HCE member for over 50 years.

- 1. Any son/daughter, stepson/stepdaughter, or grandson/granddaughter, step grandson/step granddaughter or legal ward of a Green Lake County HCE member planning to attend College/Technical College (4-year or 2-year school) currently in graduating year of high school, is eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- 2. The scholarship is open to any major.
- 3. Applicant must be in the upper half of his/her graduating class and/or have a GPA of 2.5 or better.
- 4. The applicant is required to complete the Essay Section.
- 5. Applicant will provide two (2) letters of recommendation. (For example: teacher, principal, employer.)
- 6. Applicant will complete and submit the **Current Application Form.** Only current forms will be accepted.
- 7. When judging, give consideration to grades, recommendations, work history, activities and essay.
