

GREEN LAKE COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP AND KEY AWARD APPLICATION



Space Camp – Huntsville, Alabama (April 16-20, 2020)

Space Camp is a fun-filled educational weekend at the U.S. Space & Rocket Center in Huntsville, AL: participants will complete a simulated Space Shuttle mission, experience training simulators, tour the U.S. Space & Rocket Center and learn about becoming an astronaut. *Participation as a delegate is open to enrolled 4-H members in good standing in their counties who are in 6th – 8th grades. (The trips costs about \$625 with three (3) \$350.00 scholarships available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association)*

American Spirit Experience – Travels East (June 5-14, June 10-18 or July 3-12, 2020)

The American Spirit Experience is a wonderful opportunity to develop knowledge of America's heritage, citizenship, and leadership. It is also a great opportunity to meet new people, develop leadership and public speaking skills, and travel the east coast. Approximately 40 Wisconsin youth will learn about America's heritage and build awareness of the many steps taken to gain U.S. independence and freedom by visiting historical sites in Philadelphia, New York, Boston, and more. *Participation as a delegate is open to all 4-H youth in 8th-10th grades. (The trip cost is \$1300 with up to two (2) \$800 scholarships available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association)*

Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference – Madison, WI (June 22-25, 2020)

Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference is a three and a half day Statewide Educational Experience. Youth from all over Wisconsin come to Madison for educational seminars, assemblies, speakers, exploration, and fun on the UW-Madison campus! Highlights of the different parts of Youth Conference that come together to make it a wonderful Educational Experience include hands-on seminars, interactive assemblies, and exploration of UW-Madison campus! *Participation as a delegate is open to all 4-H youth in 7th-10th grades. (The trip costs about \$250 with up to five (5) \$150 scholarships available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association)*

Citizenship Washington Focus, Washington, D.C. – (June 13-21 or July 4-12, 2020)

4-H members ages 15-19 have the opportunity to travel to D.C. with others from the state of Wisconsin and spend a week at the National 4-H Center in Chevy Chase, Maryland. In addition to attending workshops on democracy, participants will visit memorials commemorating our nation's leaders and representing our victories and defeats on the battlefield, venture through the Smithsonian Museum, chat with our nation's leaders, and see citizenship in action. Participants must be in 10th – 12th grade to apply. (The trip costs about \$1400 with one (1) \$800 scholarship available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association)

Leadership Washington Focus, Washington, D.C. – (July 26-31, 2020)

This is a new trip being offered to 4-H members in grades 6-8 to have the opportunity to travel to National 4-H Center with other youth from Wisconsin and around the country. This program focuses on building confidence and motivational skills along with public speaking. In addition, participants will visit Washington D.C. memorials and will close out the week's events with a "Leader's Ball" of a formal catered dinner followed with a dance. Participants must be in 6th – 8th grade to apply. (The trip costs about \$1200 with one (1) scholarship available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association – amount of scholarship to be determined at the September Leaders' meeting)

National Congress – Atlanta, Georgia (November 27-December 1, 2020)

National 4-H Congress is a five-day Educational Experience held in Atlanta, GA. Congress is the premiere nation-wide event for 4-Hers to network with others from around the country, Canada, and Puerto Rico. While at Congress, 4-Hers engage in leadership, citizenship, global awareness, and inclusion. Each delegate selects an issue and collaborates with youth from across the country in an effort to help better direct future 4-H programming. Delegates spend the majority of time contributing to stimulating, task-oriented groups. One day is spent on Capitol Hill meeting with Wisconsin legislators. *Applicants must be in* 10th - 12th grade at time of selection. Maximum age is 18 as of January 1st. (The trip costs about \$1,200 with one (1) \$800 scholarship available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association)

Wisconsin 4-H Key Award

The highest level of award that can be achieved by a 4-H member in the State of Wisconsin, it is an achievement only a few can be proud to receive. The Key Award is presented to 4-H members that have shown growth and strong involvement throughout their participation in 4-H. They also need to show participation in club, county and community activities. *Applicants must be in 10th - 13th grade at time of selection and a member of GLC 4-H for a minimum of three years. There are up to two (2) awards available each year.*

Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association Academic Scholarship

The Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association each year sponsors three (3) \$500.00 academic scholarships that can be used at any public or private college, university or technical school. Youth can only be selected once for this scholarship. Applicants must be a high school senior or college freshman at time of selection and a member of GLC 4-H for a minimum of three years. There are up to three (3) scholarships available each year.
