- **July 1st** - Submit fair entry by the deadline.
- **July 1st**- *Auction participation requirement*- Complete YQCA certification by this date. If youth signed up for YQCA online using 4HOnline login, the Extension Office has access to your certificate. FFA youth or youth who did not sign in using 4HOnline account must submit certification to morgan.martinez@wisc.edu by this deadline.
- **July 1st**- Youth participating in the Auction are encouraged to submit the following information to be included in the PowerPoint presentation that plays during the Buyer Appreciation Dinner at the Fair:
 - Picture of youth with or without their animal(s)
 - Parent or Guardian name(s)
 - Club/Organization
 - Number of years in exhibiting: beef, dairy, poultry, rabbit, sheep, swineAll information should be e-mailed to Connie Bobek at conbobekwi@yahoo.com
- **July 30th**- *Auction participation requirement*- By this date youth must have attended at least one Livestock Council meeting or attended an educational experience with submission of program evaluation form.
