- **May 1st-** *Auction participation requirement* Youth's family must sign up to complete a responsibility for the Green Lake County Livestock Council in order to participate in the Green Lake County Fair Auction. Visit the Livestock Council website for more information
- June 16th- Livestock Council meeting at 7:30 p.m.
- July 1st Submit fair entry by the deadline.
- July 1st- Auction participation requirement- Complete YQCA certification by this date. If youth signed up for YQCA online using 4HOnline login, the Extension Office has access to your certificate. FFA youth or

youth who did not sign in using 4HOnline account must submit certification to <u>morgan.martinez@wisc.edu</u> by this deadline.

- July 1st- Youth participating in the Auction are encouraged to submit the following information to be included in the PowerPoint presentation that plays during the Buyer Appreciation Dinner at the Fair:
 - Picture of youth with or without their animal(s)
 - Parent or Guardian name(s)
 - Club/Organization
