The Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association will be selecting the recipients of the Wisconsin 4-H Key Award and the Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association academic scholarships. Completion of 4-H Record Book is not a requirement for applying.

Wisconsin 4-H Key Award-

The highest level of award that can be achieved by a 4-H member in the State of Wisconsin, it is an achievement only a few can be proud to receive. The Key Award is presented to 4-H members that have shown growth and strong involvement throughout their participation in 4-H. They also need to show participation in club, county and community activities.

Applicants must be in 10th - 13th grade at time of selection and a member of GLC 4-H for a minimum of three years. There are up to two (2) awards available each year.

Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association Academic Scholarship-

The Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association each year sponsors three (3) \$500.00 academic scholarships that can be used at any public or private college, university or technical school. Youth can only be selected once for this scholarship. *Applicants must be a high school senior or college freshman at time of selection and a member of GLC 4-H for a minimum of three years. There are up to three (3) scholarships available each year.*

Applications and reference forms are due to the Green Lake County Extension office, or postmarked, by **Friday, March 5, 2021**. All applicants will be asked to participate in a short interview.
