Young people may participate in these experiences without receiving a scholarship from the Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association. In addition, we will also be selecting the recipients of the Wisconsin 4-H Key Award and the Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association academic scholarships.

In this document you will find a more detailed description of these educational travel opportunities and awards along with a scholarship application and reference form. *Note: Completing a Green Lake County 4-H Record Book is not a requirement to apply for these scholarship opportunities, but strongly encouraged.*

At this time WI 4-H has not shared out information if a 4-H and Youth Conference will be held. If this experience is held, scholarship information will become available at that time.

Please note WI 4-H deadlines for registering for these experiences are earlier than the Green Lake County 4-H Scholarship application:

- American Spirit due by January 14, 2022
- Citizenship Washington Focus due by January 3, 2022
- National 4-H Conference due by January 2, 2022

Wisconsin 4-H registration for these experiences are available through 4HOnline.

Applications and reference forms are due to the Green Lake County Extension office, or postmarked, by **January 15, 2022**. All applicants will be asked to participate in a short interview date, format, and location to be decided.

WI 4-H application for these experiences are listed below each experience and are earlier than the Green Lake County 4-H Scholarship and Key Award Application.

American Spirit Experience – Travels East (June 3-12, June 10-19 or June 17-29, 2022)

The American Spirit Experience is a wonderful opportunity to develop knowledge of America's heritage, citizenship, and leadership. It is also a great opportunity to meet new people, develop leadership and public speaking skills, and travel the east coast. Wisconsin youth will learn about America's heritage and build awareness of the many steps taken to gain U.S. independence and freedom by visiting historical sites in Philadelphia, New York, Boston, and more. *Participation as a delegate is open to all 4-H youth in 8th-10th grades. (The trip cost is \$1650 with up to two (2) \$800 scholarships available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association)*

WI 4-H Registration in 4HOnline January 3-14, 2022

Citizenship Washington Focus – Washington, D.C. (June 11-18 or July 2-9, 2022)

In this experience young people spend a week in the Washington D.C area learning the importance of civic and social responsibilities relating to the development of better citizens and leaders. In addition to attending workshops on democracy, participants will visit memorials commemorating our nation's leaders and representing our victories and defeats on the battlefield, venture through the Smithsonian Museum, chat with our nation's leaders, and see citizenship in action. *Participants must be in 10th – 12th grade to apply (minimum age 15 during the experience). (The trip costs about \$1750 with one (1) \$800 scholarship available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association)*

WI 4-H Registration in 4HOnline December 2, 2021 – January 3, 2022

National 4-H Conference – Washington, D.C. (March 20-24, 2022)

National 4-H Conference annually brings 4-H youth and adults from around the nation to work towards strengthening and expanding the 4-H Youth Development program at the local, state, and national levels. National 4-H Conference is the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture's premier youth development opportunity to engage youth in developing recommendations for the 4-H Youth Development Program. *Applicants must be in 10th - 12th grade at time of selection. Minimum age 15 and maximum age is 18 as of January 1st. (The trip costs about \$1,500 with \$800 scholarship available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association)*

WI 4-H Registration in 4HOnline December 2, 2021 - January 2, 2022

Wisconsin 4-H Key Award

The highest level of award that can be achieved by a 4-H member in the State of Wisconsin, it is an achievement only a few can be proud to receive. The Key Award is presented to 4-H members that have shown growth and strong involvement throughout their participation in 4-H. They also need to show participation in club, county and community activities. *Applicants must be in 10th - 13th grade at time of selection and a member of GLC 4-H for a minimum of three years. There are up to two (2) awards available each year.*

Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association Academic Scholarship

The Green Lake County 4-H Leaders' Association each year sponsors three (3) \$500.00 academic scholarships that can be used at any public or private college, university or technical school. Youth can only be selected once for this scholarship. *Applicants must be a high school senior or college freshman at time of selection and a member of GLC 4-H for a minimum of three years. There are up to three (3) scholarships available each year.*
