

What is 4-H?

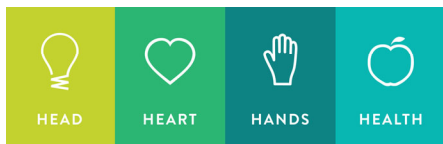
From hands-on exploration to project-based skill building, young people thrive in 4-H clubs, finding their way to success in life and career. We do that by teaching the four H's:

Your contribution will support 4-H youth participation in a variety of educational experiences.

Some of the programs contributions in 2021 supported:

- ◆ 4-H Summer Day Camp for youth, where they explored cultural arts through tie dying, learned and applied the Engineer



Design Process to construct a variety of bridges that withstood weight, applied newly learned skills in the electricity project to build an LED wand, learned about nutrition through making a healthy snack, and practiced teambuilding skills when given variety of activities.

- ◆ Take and Learn Project kits are designed youth to experience hands-on project learning and explore the projects 4-H has to offer.



Each kit contains nearly all needed materials and learning guides to complete projects. Kits also included a virtual component providing young people the opportunity to connect, learn, and reflect with others in a virtual setting.

Project kits included exploring quilt block design to painting their own wooden barn quilt, applying knowledge of the engineer design process to construct an edible gingerbread house, and used candy to explore chemical reactions and density!
