**To:** Swine, Sheep, Beef Exhibitors who completed 2022 GLC Fair Tagging Form

**From:** Green Lake County Livestock Council

Youth must identify their animals by putting provided Green Lake County Fair ear tags (or WI State Fair RFID ear tags) in the market animal's ear and submit animal identification.

### Tagging Pick-Up:

Beginning April 19<sup>th</sup>, tagging packets labeled with family name can be picked up at Green Lake County Extension Office Conference Room (walk in Extension Office and conference room is located immediately to the right). The Extension Office is open Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. If unable to pick-up, contact the Extension Office for mailing option.

### Tagging Rules:

- Green Lake County Fair Auction Tags may only be used for the year that those tags were issued. Green Lake County Fair Auction Tag colors will be changed on an annual basis to avoid any duplicate numbers as animals are processed
- Lost Tags must be reported to the Green Lake County Livestock Council Board immediately after the tag is lost. A new tag will be issued along with a new Animal ID Sheet. The lost tag must be replaced and the Animal ID sheet must be submitted to GLC Livestock Council before that animal reaches the Green Lake County Fair.
- The Green Lake County Livestock Council will accept Wisconsin State Fair RFID tags in place of a Green Lake County Fair Auction Tag.

### Species Tag Colors

Please ensure you are placing the correct tag colors in the correct species' ear:

- Yellow Tags = Sheep
- Blue and Green Tags = Swine
- Purple and Green Tags = Beef
- White Tags = Beef

**Animal Identification: Due May 8, 2022 at 11:59 p.m.**

### How To Submit Your Identification Information:

In addition to self-tagging, youth must complete and submit Green Lake County Fair Animal Identification for each animal (beef, sheep, swine) being tagged for the Green Lake County Fair Auction. **Animal identification must be submitted by May 8, 2022 at 11:59 p.m. Late submissions will not be accepted.**

**Online Submission:** Complete one Animal Identification Form per family that includes all the animals which you are identifying. The online Animal Identification Form link is located on the Livestock Council website or at <https://go.wisc.edu/9ds8ae>.
