4-H Program Educator – Morgan

- Discussed the Thriving Survey. The survey consists of youth ages 13 – 18. Green Lake County 4-H's overall grade is 5.7 (on a scale from 1-7). Morgan went through the details

of all 5 categories. Youth sparks is our lowest score at 5.1. Morgan stated this showed great results for Green Lake County. The response rate for Green Lake County was 18% - 20%.

- Spring Project Kit Updates – 50 kits were given to Green Lake County youth. 50 kits were also given to Marquette County youth. The projects the youth could pick from were duct tape crafts, robotics, cake pops and gummy bears.

Bookkeeper Computer

- Purchasing a new computer was discussed. The quote presented was from Waushara PC. The cost would be between \$650 - \$700 (includes computer, Microsoft Word & Excel, service fee for time and labor). The following is the computer information: Brand – ASUS, CPU – Intel N4020, Screen Size – 14.0”, Operating System – Windows 11, Intel UHD Graphics, SSD – 128 GB, Memory – 4 GB, and free one year Microsoft Office 365. Discussed if Microsoft Word and Excel were necessary as that would turn into an annual fee. It was decided Microsoft Word and Excel were needed. Dan made a motion to purchase the computer as it is stated in the quote with the addition of a security program. Pat 2nd the motion. Motion carried.
