## American Spirit Experience – (Last Year's Dates: June 14-23, June 21-30, July 5-14, 2024):

The American Spirit Experience is a wonderful opportunity to develop knowledge of America's heritage, citizenship, and leadership. It is also a great opportunity to meet new people, develop leadership and public speaking skills, and travel the east coast. Wisconsin youth will learn about America's heritage and build awareness of the many steps taken to gain U.S. independence and freedom by visiting historical sites in Philadelphia, New York, Boston, and more.

Participation as a delegate is open to all 4-H youth in 8<sup>th</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> grades. (The trip cost is approximately \$1900 with up to two (2) scholarships covering 75% of the cost available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association) Additional scholarships may be available at the state level!

## Citizenship Washington Focus (CWF) – Washington, D.C. (Dates available Late 2024 - typically June)

In this experience young people spend a week in the Washington D.C area learning the importance of civic and social responsibilities relating to the development of better citizens and leaders. In addition to attending workshops on democracy, participants will visit memorials commemorating our nation's leaders and representing our victories and defeats on the battlefield, venture through the Smithsonian Museum, chat with our nation's leaders, and see citizenship in action.

Participants must be in  $10^{th} - 12^{th}$  grade to apply (must be 15 years old at the time of this experience). (The trip costs approximately \$2,500 with one (1) scholarship covering 75% of the cost available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association) Additional scholarships may be available at the state level!

#### National 4-H Conference – Washington, D.C. (April 11-16, 2025)

The National 4-H Conference annually brings 4-H youth and adults from around the nation to work towards strengthening and expanding the 4-H Youth Development program at the local, state, and national levels. National 4-H Conference is the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture's premier youth development opportunity to engage youth in developing recommendations for the 4-H Youth Development Program.

Participants must be in  $10^{th} - 12^{th}$  grade at time of selection. Minimum age 15 and maximum age is 18 as of January  $1^{st}$ . (The trip cost is approximately \$00 with one ((1) scholarship covering 75% of the cost available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association) Additional scholarships may be available at the state level!

Join us on the UW-Madison Campus for Summer Academy. Dates for 2025 have not yet been announced. This Positive Youth Development program will help you discover future college and career pathways. See what life on campus or on the job looks like within various tracks. Tracks include several SPARK areas including agriculture, STEM, service, leadership, arts, trades, and many more. There will be fun opportunities to build networks and friendships with folks from all over the state of WI.

Participants must be in 7<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> grade to apply. (This trip costs is approximately \$450 dollars with five (5) scholarships covering 75% of the costs available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association) Additional scholarships may be available at the state level!

The Space Camp Experience is a wonderful camp opportunity to learn about and experience life as an astronaut, working at NASA, and exploring things that are out of this world! You will experience the pathfinder program including a Simulated Space Mission, other space simulators, building and launching model rockets, learn about

space exploration, and even compete in a quiz bowl. Participation as a delegate is open to all 4-H youth

in  $6^{th} - 8^{th}$  grades (Must be 15 years old at the time of the experience). (The trip cost is approximately \$1300 with up to three (3) scholarships covering 75% of the cost available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association) Additional scholarships may be available at the state level!

(The trip costs approximately \$2700 with one (1) scholarship covering 75% of the cost available from the GLC 4-H Leaders' Association) Additional scholarships may be available at the state level!

The Key Aware is the highest level of award in the State of Wisconsin is an achievement only a few 4-H'ers can be proud to receive. The Key Award is presented to 4-H members that have shown growth and strong involvement throughout their participation in 4-H. They also need to show participation in club, county and community activities. Applicants must be in 10th - 13th grade at time of selection and a member of GLC 4-H for a minimum of three years. There are up to two (2) awards available each year.

This award is present at the 2025 Green Lake County Fair and recognition as well as award payment at the 2025 Leaders' Banquet in November.
