The goal is to create a poster that shows the importance of habitats.

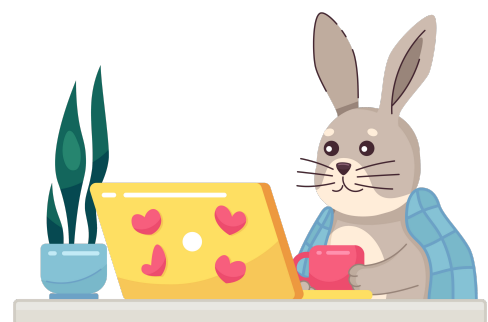
"A habitat is a place where an organism makes its home. A habitat meets all the environmental conditions an organism needs to survive.

For an animal, that means everything it needs to find and gather food, select a mate, and successfully reproduce. For a plant, a good habitat must provide the right combination of light, air, water, and soil.

The main components of a habitat are shelter, water, food, and space. A habitat is said to have a suitable arrangement when it has the correct amount of all of these." - Poster Contest Details, Land Conservation

Do you enjoy making, learning, and or even just appreciating all things art? Be on the lookout for the upcoming application to become a Wisconsin 4-H Arts Ambassador! Application period is set to open Nov. 15th and run through Dec. 20th!

### What happened to the State Arts Teams?

Nothing is going away! The past State Arts Teams (Drama Company and Art Team) will now fall under the "Wisconsin 4-H Arts Ambassadors" umbrella. This will allow more collaboration and leadership from a larger group of youth when it comes to planning participation in various statewide events.

### What do Art Ambassadors do?

The Wisconsin 4-H Arts Ambassadors provide a voice into the statewide 4-H arts and how they exist at 4-H events throughout the year including Summer Academy, Fall Forum, Arts Camps, and also County-based programs. There are various teams that youth can join within the Art Ambassadors umbrella:

#### Drama Company

- This group creates a stage performance involving acting, song and dance in the five days leading up to the Summer Academy. You will also learn leadership skills, perform, create and develop lifelong skills related to growth management, resilience, collaboration and explore personal sparks.

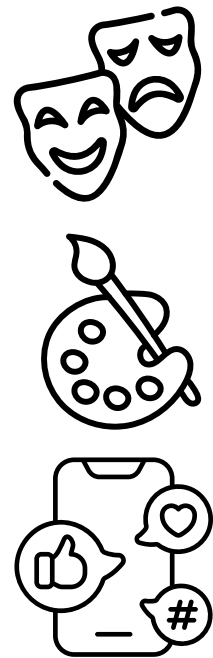

#### Art Team

- This group creates artwork around the theme of the Summer Academy as well as designing and organizing the Summer Academy Art Exhibit, reception, and guided exhibit tours. The team members also teach seminars and train to be peer leaders for county and regional events including Fall Forum. The 4-H Art Team is led by a professional artist who teaches team members artistic techniques using a variety of mediums.

#### Communications, Media, and Marketing Team (NEW THIS YEAR!)

- This group creates original content, (Video, social media, digital promotional materials) to promote the 4-H story in Wisconsin. Working with an advisor, you will build a community of digital storytellers through skill development, and hands on practice.



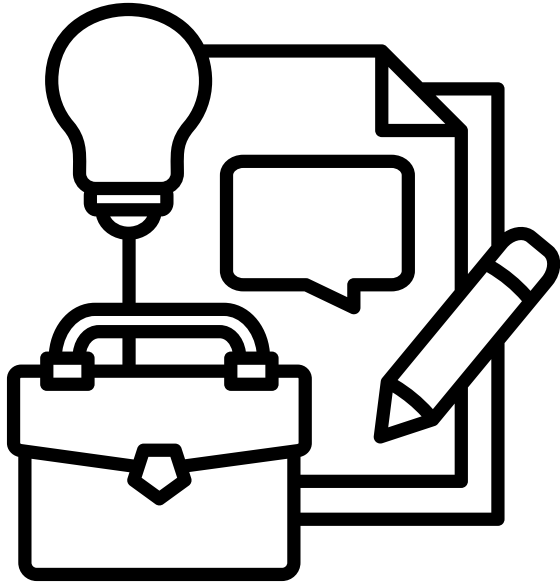
### Not an "Artist"?
